SMOKE AND VAPING FREE POLICY

Rationale:

The Board of Trustees is committed to ensuring that the requirements and objectives of the Smoke-free Environments Act 1990 are met to prevent, so far as is reasonably practicable, the detrimental effects of smoking on the health of non-smokers within the school and its environment.

Guidelines:

- 1. The Board of Trustees is committed to maintaining a smoke and vaping free environment within the school and its grounds.
- 2. The Board of Trustees has a commitment to ensure that staff and students are protected from tobacco smoke and vaping smoke, thus maintaining the highest environmental standards in respect of smoke.
- 3. The Board of Trustees will take all reasonable practicable steps to ensure that no person smokes or vapes within the school or its grounds at any time on any day.
- 4. The Board of Trustees will ensure that prominent notices prohibiting smoking and vaping are displayed in appropriate places throughout the school and the school grounds.
- 5. The Board of Trustees will ensure that there is a programme in place to ensure students are educated about the detrimental effects of smoking and vaping on health.

Review

1. As required by section 5(5) of the Smoke-free Environments Act 1990, this policy will be reviewed in accordance with our normal review cycle.
